Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Delhi - City of Legacies and Layers

Day 3 - Agra - The Monument of Love and Power

Travel by road to Agra, the city of love and emperors. Visit the imposing Agra Fort, where battles were fought and emperors once ruled. Then behold the grandeur of the Taj Mahal at sunset, from the peaceful Mehtab Bagh, framed by the Yamuna River.

Day 4 - Journey to Orchha - Time Stands Still in Stone

Drive to Orchha, Madhya Pradesh's best-kept secret. This riverside town once served as the capital of the Bundela kings. Explore the Orchha Fort Complex, featuring palaces with delicate murals and commanding towers. Enjoy the relaxed, rustic ambiance as history echoes through every courtyard.
☐ **Overnight stay in Orchha.**

Day 5 - Palaces, Temples & Cenotaphs - Orchha's Royal Canvas

Spend a full day exploring Orchha's unique blend of Rajput and Mughal architecture. Marvel at the soaring Chaturbhuji Temple, the intricately designed Raj Mahal, and the

serene cenotaphs (chhatris) lining the Betwa River. This hidden town offers stories of valor, romance, and deep devotion.
☐Overnight stay in Orchha.

Day 6 - Drive to Khajuraho - Enter the Temple Kingdom

Today, travel to Khajuraho, a UNESCO World Heritage site famed for its breathtaking temples. Check into your hotel and relax for the evening. Optional: Attend a light and sound show that narrates the story of Khajuraho's rise and decline amidst soundscapes and dramatic lighting.
☐ Overnight stay in Khajuraho.

Day 7 - Temples of Art, Erotica & Devotion - Khajuraho Explored

Explore the world-famous Khajuraho Temples, where stone comes alive through carvings that celebrate life, love, and spirituality. Visit both the Western and Eastern Group of Temples, admiring the craftsmanship that has defied time. Each sculpture tells a story—sensual, sacred, or symbolic.
☐ Overnight stay in Khajuraho.

Day 8 - Departure from Khajuraho - Farewell to Forgotten Glories

After breakfast, enjoy free time depending on your departure schedule. You may choose to explore local crafts or simply reflect on the rich stories you've encountered. Later, transfer to the airport or railway station for your onward journey.
